AN OVERVIEW OF THE GLOBAL HUBS OF CHRISTIANITY®

There is so much of the Christian world most of us do not know about. We know our own circle of friends and acquaintances, our community, our stream of believers, or perhaps, only what we see on TV.

In order for us to complete the task of the Great Commission, of reaching the whole world for Jesus Christ, we must take a broader view, a God's eye view, of the world.

Ninety-six percent of Christians worldwide live someplace other than North America. That number has been changing over the years. We refer to this change as the circumference of Christianity with a mountain range of ministry— mountains God is raising up all over the world. And these mountains connect, either below the surface or above, in a unified range of Christendom. It's in this context that the Global HUBs of Christianity®, under the covering of the Global Church Network® (GCN), have emerged.

Over the past several years, GCN has held multiple strategic task force meetings all over the world with regional pastors and church leaders. It is our sincere belief that everyone has a role in the goal and a part in God's heart. As a result, we have engaged the Global HUBs of Christianity® initiative.

As we began, we established three key strategic priorities to give a rationale for why we are doing what we are doing:

Strategic Priority One – Discovering Leadership: We are constantly on the lookout for key leaders in the body of Christ that God has raised up or is raising up around the world. If you want to see what God is doing in a region of the world, look at who He is raising up there. This often requires you to get outside your normal paradigm, outside the normal stream you may have grown up in. Global HUBs look at both teaching ability and hands-on experience to identify leaders for the fulfillment of our mission.

Strategic Priority Two – Developing Leadership:

We place a high priority on the development of strategic church networks. We have networked with key influential leaders from metropolitan cities and global regions to launch the Global Church Divinity School® (GCDS). The GCDS includes online and hands-on courses from some of the most successful and influential pastors and teachers in the world. Of more than 100 online courses currently available, we have selected 30 from the Global Church Training Curriculum® that are now the two-year HUB training sessions.



Strategic Priority Three - Deploying Leadership: Global HUBs align our core curriculum and faculty with strategic global partners so we can better reach all nations for God's glory. We want to empower people to fulfill the divine gifts God has placed in their heart and in their life.

As we deploy leadership globally, we do so in five major categories, which also make up the components of the Global Church Divinity School® and the Global HUBs of Christianity®. They are:

- 1. Leadership Development
- 2. Global Missions
- 3. Church Multiplication
- 4. Evangelism and Discipleship
- 5. Visionary Networking

PURPOSE STATEMENT FOR THE GLOBAL HUBS OF CHRISTIANITY®

Our purpose is clear: To mobilize the whole Body of Christ to equip indigenous leaders to plant churches and work together to complete the Great Commission by 2030—the 2,000th birthday of the Church.

It is our goal to get ahead of population growth so we can finish the Great Commission in our generation.

Involved in **Strategic Priority One** is the discovery of leadership. This means those who are Great Commissionminded have been gifted by God to



move forward in this effort. The GCN believes we all have a part in the Great Commission. We want to discover additional leaders who can help make this happen.

Strategic Priority Two involves developing new leaders who are thinking of the entire circumference of Christianity. This includes making new church partners, finding more visionary leaders, targeting strategic cities, and reaching neighbors of those who are close to unreached people groups. These then flow into the Global HUBs of Christianity®, the Global Church Divinity School® and the global faculty and resources. This all funnels to the global community in the development of leaders.

Next, we look at nation-impacting communities all across the world. We partner with strategic churches and influential leaders in key metropolitan cities and regions.

To this end, we envision at least 800 HUBs in the Body of Christ by 2030. That is approximately one HUB for every 10 million people. The location of these HUBs will be up to those whom God has raised up in their particular regions. They have the heart and the knowledge for reaching their own regions for the Lord.

Strategic Priority Three involves deploying leadership. This includes recruiting, training, multiplying, and reproducing men and women who have a heart for bringing people to God.



After two years of training in the HUBs of Christianity® sessions, men and women are empowered to go out and start their own HUBs if they are so inclined. We believe at least 10 percent of the participants will end up doing that. We must strategically reproduce godly leadership in order to finish the Great Commission anytime soon. Experts in global population growth have said that if we miss the opportunity now, in this generation, it could be hundreds of more years before we might be able to come close again.

The church of Jesus Christ is in a race against the clock. Each day around the globe, 158,857 men, women and children die. This includes approximately 66,000 who have never had access to the Gospel. That's 2,750 people per hour and 49 people per minute who go to their graves without ever hearing the Good News of Jesus Christ! These numbers don't even count those who have heard the Gospel in their lifetimes but died lost.

How would the world respond to the crashing of 132 airplanes and the killing of 66,000 people day after day after day? You can be sure that a massive and strategic coordination of the time, energy and resources of the world's top aviation experts would be applied in a race to stop such a horrible and unacceptable loss of life! Can the response of the Global church be any less?

For nearly 20 years, the Global Church Network® has been working to synergize and mobilize the entire Body of Christ to help fulfill the Great Commission. Now we've added a finish line: 2030— the 2,000th birthday of the church. After all, a vision doesn't become a goal until you put a date on it! We want to reach every person with the Gospel in this generation.

We call this goal FINISH 2030®, and it has six key components:

- **FIND** the world's unreached people groups and engage them.
- **INTERCEDE** for the unreached and for one another.
- **NETWORK** together for the greatest synergistic impact.
- **INVEST** our time, talent and treasure into this kingdom cause.
- **SEND** missionaries into the world regions where the Gospel isn't known.
- HARVEST together until the very last person has heard the Gospel.

The Global Church Network® has synergistically partnered with hundreds of organizations and thousands of churches around the globe, spanning virtually every denomination, stream, and world region. FINISH 2030® is about reaching even the hardest places in the world with the Gospel—sooner rather than later.

This is not something that any one person, church, denomination, or ministry organization can do alone. But it is something we can do as the Body of Christ, if we stop competing with one another and choose instead to work together to finish the race. FINISH 2030® is not about logos or egos. At GCN, we often say, "It doesn't matter who gets the credit, as long as God gets the glory!"



Currently, we have tens, of thousands of pastors and leaders taking part in the GCDS.

The Global Church Training Curriculum® consists of 30 courses that are taught in 30 languages. We have developed a student guide and a teacher to accompany these courses.

The training curriculum is focused on five categories:

- 3. Church Multiplication
- 4. Evangelism and Discipleship
- 5. Visionary Networking

Each of the five categories consists of 6-8 different courses taught by teachers all over the world. They have been put together in a seamless curriculum. Again, four sessions will be taught in a HUB over a two-year period. The Global Church Divinity School® (www.GCDS.tv) houses more than 250 interactive training curriculum courses by renowned Christian leaders from every major world region.

There are five major categories of study in the Global Church Classroom: Leadership Development, Global Missions, Church Multiplication, Evangelism/Discipleship and Visionary Networking.



When the HUB members complete their 30 Global Church Training Curriculum® courses, they will be granted full access to the Global Church Divinity School®. The seven levels in each of these tracks are novice, apprentice, specialist, docent, maven, master, and mentor. KEYS TO BUILDING YOUR HUB ATTENDANCE



How many should you expect to attend your HUB?

Numbers may vary, depending upon your location. In North America, we expect numbers between 50 and 70. In India, however, we have had HUBs exceed 400 pastors and leaders. We had almost that many in Panama City, Panama. For HUB launches in Africa, we have had over 2,000 pastors and leaders attending. In Amsterdam, we had about 50 or 60 pastors and teachers.

Every HUB will take on its own size and nature. But as a general rule, we see:

- **35–40 percent** of the HUB being made up of your local church or organization. As a pastor or leader, We are sure you will want to expose your people to the very best pastors and teachers that are available. When you help your leaders get better at their jobs, your church benefits and grows. We reproduce who we are, not what we want. Be liberal in inviting key men and women to be part of the HUB.
- 35–40 percent will probably be from your community or city as you expose them to the HUB.
- 20-30 percent will likely come from your personal circle of acquaintances. When it comes to your circle, remember your influence may reach great distances outside of your immediate area.

We suggest you reach out to other HUB leaders and learn from the things they have done, from their experiences, from the lessons they learned in hosting a HUB.

As you plan your marketing strategies, be sure to include the digital aspects. Social media and a strong presence on your website should be a part of how you get the word out to your community and your church. Keep it up day in and day out.

To recap, here are the simple steps to help make your HUB a reality:

- 1. Make a full presentation to your church.
- 2. Reach out to your community and let them know what is happening.
- 3. Reach out to your wider circle of friends. Don't let distance stop them from participating.

How to teach a course in a HUB?

As a teacher in a HUB, you are probably asking yourself, how can you teach a course you have not authored? How can you teach it with authority and conviction, even though you are not the originator of the material?



One of the first things you will need to understand is the kind of environment you are teaching in.
These are not just people sitting in a church service.
These are teachers and pastors, or potential pastors, all of whom have dedicated themselves to not only learning the Word, but teaching the Word themselves. These individuals are going to be

from all over the world. Be sensitive to that. Be sensitive to who they are and to the fact they have heard from God themselves, and that is why they are in your class.

We are so grateful you have chosen to partner with us as we move forward in the HUBs of



Christianity[®]. When we think of you as a trainer, we think of someone who is at the top of their game. That's why we have selected you to be on this team. We are serving and training together to bring the finest teachers and trainers to the entire Body of Christ. You are one of these.

When we launched the Global Church Network®, we were thinking of the entire Body of Christ, not just a select portion. We had then, and continue to have today, a world view, far beyond any country borders or church denominations.

Dr. Leonard Sweet says, "We come from different tribes." You might call them different streams. However you look at it, the Bible says we are "the Body of Christ," and we all have different functions within the body.

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The Lord gave gifts to the church. He gave apostles and prophets, evangelists, pastors and teachers. Regardless of where you feel you fall in these categories, there always remains a core preaching and teaching component that flows through all of these gifts.

All five gifts are functioning in the body today. No one is more important than the other. They all operate side by side with equal importance. The functioning of these gifts is a team effort rather than an individual effort. They are not in competition with each other.

These five gifts represent five principles.

The apostle is a governing gift. The prophet is a guiding gift. The evangelist is a gathering gift. The pastor is a quarding or protecting gift. The teacher is like a garnering gift. The pastor and teacher gifts are similar and can often be seen as interchangeable.

According to Ephesians 4, these five principles exist so the Body of Christ can mature. Therefore, we want to effect maturity in the Body of Christ with the gifts God has bestowed upon us.

To this end, The Global Church Divinity School® equips men and women within the Body of Christ so they can become more mature in their walk with God in the ministry God has set before them.

Here are some steps that can assist you as you prepare to teach courses within the HUBs of Christianity® that you have not personally authored.

- 1. Go to the Global Church Divinity School Online and locate the specific courses you have agreed to teach. Listen to the original course. Notice how the author went about teaching his or her course. Download the transcript of the course. Follow the transcript as you are listening. Make notes. Mark it up. Study what the instructor was teaching so you are very familiar with the content.
- 2. Study the master Teaching Guide. In this guide are the compounded notes of all the lectures that make up the HUB/Global Church Divinity School® Curriculum. Review it thoroughly. Remember, nothing in this guide or in the presentations are in cement. They are only guides for you as you teach these courses.

These guides are meant to lead you, not dictate you. You may want to linger at a location for a bit before moving on. You are free to do this. You may decide to skip over a portion. That is okay as well. Feel free to use your own life stories and experiences in your illustrations. The guide is flexible and can be adapted for your specific teaching style. Remember: blessed are the flexible, for they shall not be bent out of shape.

God has equipped you to be a teacher and a preacher, and part of that is being able to be flexible and creative. God wants to harness that gift for the benefit of the pastors and leaders in the HUBs.

- 3. Craft the course the way you want to teach it. Remember, you can be flexible. You can move portions around. You can teach one part first and another part second. It's your call. Make the course your own. Customize it so you are comfortable with the material. There may be sections you want to remove due to time constraints. That's fine, because all of the students are going to be hearing the original courses as well in the GCDS. Each of them will have a Student Guide. You, too, have access to the Student Guide if you want to see what the students will be reading.
- **4.** If you have time and desire, it is recommended that you use the PowerPoint Slides we have developed for each course. They are on the Global Church Divinity School® HUB resources Website. You can download these slides and customize them to your liking. When you have done this, be sure to send them to the host HUB coordinator in advance, especially if they are going to be in a different language. This will allow them time to have them translated.
- 5. It is highly recommended that you reach out to other HUB trainers, especially the one(s) you will be teaching alongside. They will likely have some ideas and lessons learned from their experiences that would assist you. Remember, you are teaching with another person. It's a tagteam effort. Just as Jesus sent his disciples out two-by-two to teach and preach, we are sending

you out with another trainer. Reach out and get a sense of how he or she is doing. Share your thoughts and coordinate your efforts to build synergy in the courses you are going to be teaching.

It is an honor to partner with you and to synergize with you. We are deeply indebted for the use of your time, talent and treasure, and for your willingness to travel, often to distant places, to teach and train men and women throughout the entire Body of Christ.





FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- What is the purpose of a Global HUB of Christianity®? The primary purpose of the Global HUBs of Christianity® is to mobilize the whole Body of Christ to equip indigenous leaders to plant churches and work together to complete the Great Commission by 2030—the 2,000th birthday of the church. Individually, each HUB is intended to be a regional center for providing world-class teaching and training for pastors, leaders, and others who want to increase their effectiveness in the harvest field.
- What does an attendee receive for his/her participation in a HUB? Over the course of the four sessions, attendees receive face-to-face, world-class instruction of 30 core courses from the Global Church Divinity School® (www.GCDS.tv). In addition, each person receives a membership to the Global Church Divinity School® (valued up to \$1,000 per year) and a Global Church Training Curriculum® Guide.
- How often do HUB sessions meet for training? All attendees meet at the HUB four separate times over a two-year period. The four sessions are approximately six months apart.
- How much does it cost to register? We encourage HUBs to keep the cost to participants as low as possible. However, it is understood that costs are incurred with each session, and HUBs may ask for assistance in recouping those expenses. If you are interested in registering, please check with the local HUB host—church/ministry—for the exact registration fee.
- How does a person register for a HUB? Registration is accomplished through the local church/ministry that is serving as a HUB. Each HUB church/ministry is encouraged to create a page on its website where individuals can go to register.
- How are registration funds used? For all HUBs outside of the United States, 100% of the registration income remains with the HUB. In the US, 70% of the registration income remains with the host HUB and 30% of the income is sent to the Global Church Network®.
- Is the registered person expected to attend all four training sessions? Yes. It is understood that unexpected circumstances may occur. However, if the person wishes to graduate, he/she should explain to the local HUB pastor why a particular session was missed. The missed teaching can then be completed online in the Global Church Divinity School® to fulfill the commitment.

GLOBAL HUBS OF CHRISTIANITY® FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- Where should attendees stay during their HUB training? Each local HUB is encouraged to provide recommendations for nearby hotels. However, it is the attendee's responsibility to make their own reservations and cover their own costs.
- What does the local HUB need to do to get ready for the first session?
 - Select a room in your building to serve as the classroom. It should be large enough to accommodate a minimum of 50-75 attendees, or larger if additional attendees register.
 - The room needs good lighting, a whiteboard, Internet access, work tables and chairs. A projector and screen are also needed if PowerPoints will be used in the teaching.
 - For each day of training, provide a simple lunch onsite for each attendee.
 - Promote and market with materials adapted from or provided by Global Church Network® (flyers, posters, video, website, etc.).
 - Send promotional letters to your members, fellow pastors, and church leaders in your region.
 - Promote the program in your church bulletin and on your church website.
 - Identify a few local hotels that can be recommended to attendees.
- Can the local pastor also be one of the trainers? The local pastor can possibly serve as a trainer (after conferring with the HUB leadership team), or participate as a student with other attendees.
